Belonging: Designing safe and inclusive spaces for ALL to thrive.










President Barack Obama signing the Don't Ask, Don't Tell Repeal Act of 2010 into Law at the Department of the Interior - December 22, 2010.



Incorporates a dangerous and fundamental belief that the group member can be cured from sexual immorality.


A fringe space in the moral dilemma. Out of the closet, but not seated at the table.


