Environment for the different types of plans

- Grandfathered Plan
- Extended Plan Grandmother Plans
- Early Renewals
- Metallic- Under 50 groups
- Self-Funded
- Semi Self-Funded

Where are Premium going?

- Uncertainty of costs for your particular plan and planning for your renewal
- Taxes from PPACA
- More rules on 'creative' financing put up roadblocks
- Who is the hardest hit with increases?

Good news

- Composite rating coming back to small group
- Trend rates in some plan going back to "normal" in some cases
- A little more certainty on what is going on in the marketplace/open community pool
- Carriers fixing plans that didn't work
- Some metallic plans more robust
- Employees enjoying the "wellness" section

Quick List of Notifications that Need to Go Out

Best	

- Give as many notifications during open enrollment and onboarding
- Being prepared at open enrollment to get everything out

New way of describing plans - SBC

- A few facts about the SBC –
 Summary of Benefit & Coverage
 Requirements
- What needs to be on, what doesn't
- Potential risk area fines

How to get those notices out?

- Snail mail by first class or hand delivered to employees home address
- Computer with the return-receipt feature (if something that is typically used for their job)
 - Enrollment on line
 - Posted on Intranet with notifications where posted
- Lots of small print

Biggest upcoming challenges facing employers this coming year

- Understanding & controlling your numbers
- Affordability
- IRS Reporting
 - A good payroll system will become essential
- Your individual plan eligibility issues are in compliance

Looming issues on the horizons

- Discrimination Laws
 - Similar to the ERISA laws but rumored to be even more stringent
- Cadillac Tax Value Added
 –40% excise tax
