





SHRM Chapter Membership Requirements as of January 1, 2012

100%-Chapters

- Minimum of 25 SHRM members
 AND
- 100% SHRM membership

Non-100%-Chapters

- Minimum of 25 SHRM members
 AND
- 51% SHRM membership

Applies to all existing and new chapters - no grandfathering. Chapters not currently meeting new affiliation requirements will have a five-year period to do so (by **December 31, 2016**).



Commitment to Chapters

SHRM Chapters and State Councils will also be eligible for enhanced chapter support based on the number of SHRM certified members at the end of 2015 and 2016.

- State Councils will earn \$10 for every SHRM National member in the state who is SHRM certified on December 31, 2015
- Chapters in good standing will earn \$20 for every SHRM National member who designates the chapter as his/her primary and who is SHRM certified on December 31, 2015
- Incentive program will continue in 2016 as well
- Payments will be made in January 2016 and January 2017
